Shelter Updates

We're excited to share the improvements completed on our beach shelter this year. During the 2025 season, the building received a full facelift featuring a brand-new steel roof, updated steel siding, and refreshed soffits and fascia. Combined with the beautiful cement sidewalk generously donated last year by the Highland Lions Club, the shelter is looking absolutely wonderful!

These upgrades have greatly enhanced both the appearance and durability of the space, ensuring a more enjoyable experience for all who use it.

With over \$20,000 invested in these improvements, we will be updating our rental rates to better support ongoing maintenance and park enhancements. Beginning this season, the daily rental rate for the beach shelter will be \$75, and the Group Shelter will be available for \$50 per day.

These devices open up new possibilities, allowing more visitors to enjoy our trails, scenery, and wildlife in a meaningful and independent way.

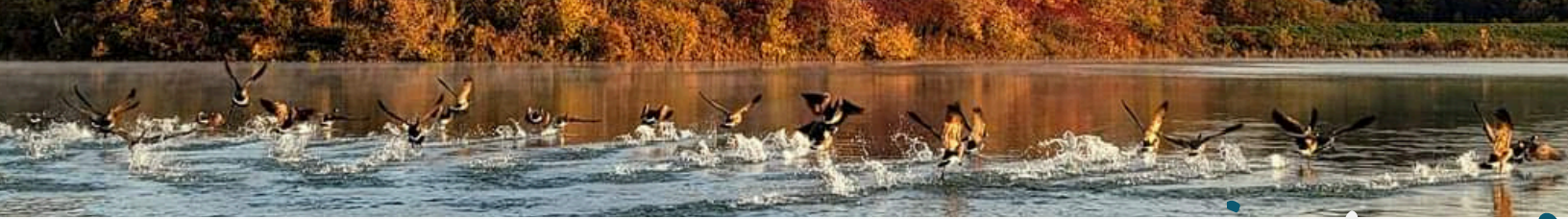

RESERVATIONS FOR THE 2026 SEASON!

In-Person Reservation Day

Saturday, January 10th 2026

- Reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis.
- We will be implementing a numbering system (like in years past.) Our staff is depending on your integrity and honesty to make sure this is done correctly;
 - You cannot pick the next number in line and then leave the premises.
 - You MUST stay in line or in the parking lot once you have drawn your number.
 - You may NOT pick a number for someone who isn't present.
- Numbers will be served in order. No skipping in line or trading numbers. (If you are planning on making reservations with another group, make sure you get here at the same time to get numbers next to each other.
- We will open the office at 7:00am and start processing the in-person reservations in order.
- When you get to the front office, have your reservations READY!
 - Please know what site/sites you would like and have your dates picked out and ready to go.

- We ask that you remain respectful and patient during this process. • This is a very long day for customers and staff!
- There will be forms available on the website AND in the nature center for you to fill out to keep all of your reservations organized.

Reservation Request Forms

- We will NOT be accepting reservation request forms for the 2026 season. Forms are to organize reservations only!

Over the Phone Reservations

- We will start taking over the phone reservations on Monday, January 12th 2026.
- The phone will not be answered before 8am and the office will be open for regular off season hours.
- Please keep in mind that we only have ONE phone line. Be patient with our staff.
- THE PHONE WILL NOT BE ANSWERED JANUARY 10th OR JANUARY 11th!!!

Online Reservations

- Online booking will begin at 8am on February 2nd, 2026.
- Online Reservation Fees will be \$10.00 per reservation.

Full payment must be received at the time of reservation!

Bank Reshaping Project

We're excited to share that another major improvement to the park wrapped up in late spring of this year. Thanks to the hard work and partnership with Kevin Wienkes Construction, our boat mooring area is looking better than ever! This improvement has created a much more enjoyable area for our seasonal pontoon spot holders AND the individuals that use our most popular hiking trail!

Here's What We Did...

- Eleven of the pontoon mooring spots at the boat landing were leveled and now have new posts.
- The trailhead to one of our most popular hiking trails got a much-needed update.
- These improvements are helping eliminate erosion in the bay - great news for local wildlife and water quality.
- The dirt was hauled away to group site 1 and repurposed to level off the campsite.



New Signage

Over the last few years, the old wooden signage in the park has been quickly deteriorating. This summer, we updated all of the old wooden signs and even added some new ones to help distinguish trail heads within the recreation area. We've received many compliments that the new signs are much easier to see and are extremely helpful in navigating the hiking trails.

With the help of our awesome staff, we were able to complete this project in just two (very hot and rainy) days. They were wonderful help with removing the old signage and installing the new posts!

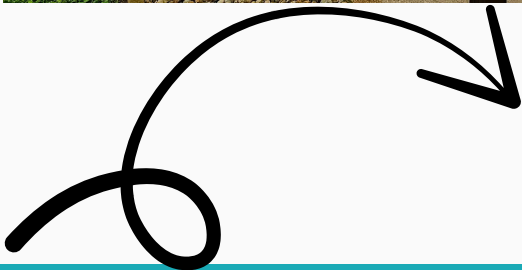


Office Updates

Back in 2022, we did a complete remodel of the inside of our office building. This year, we worked hard to make the outside look as inviting as the inside. We cleaned up around the outside of the building, pressure washed the sidewalk and siding, added benches, painted the trim and support beams, and even added some lights.

We then went one step further and ripped out the old rock beds and edging in front of the office. We laid new plastic, edging, and landscaping rock. The look really came together with some new potted plants.

Our last addition (that we are extremely proud of,) is our brand new life sized statue of Chief Blackhawk. This wooden carving was made by Casey Bartels of Casey's Chainsaw Carvings. It adds something so special to our office space and really encapsulates the meaning behind our beautiful park!
